EVS Project “Utilapu workcamps” (0-HU-17) Hongarije - Budapest
Project In the first few weeks the volunteers will attend an intensive language course in the morning. In the afternoon they will come to the office to meet the staff and develop an idea of the activities of the organisation and gradually join in. In the summer the volunteers will participate in the organisation and co-ordination of workcamps. They will also be involved in some of the other projects run by Útilapu dealing with issues like social exclusion, equal opportunities, environment, youth policies, peace, antiracism. In the autumn the volunteers will help in the evaluation of the summer activities. This includes the organisation of a meeting for those who were in workcamps around the world. A camp leader training will also take place in the autumn. Having been involved in different areas of activities carried out by Útilapu, the volunteers can choose the area they want to focus on. They should plan and develop their own project for the second part of their EVS programmes. This project could include for example teaching languages to socially underprivileged children, dealing with refugees, organise a campaign on an important issue etc
Organisatie Útilapu Hálózát is part of an international organisation, Service Civil International, and this Hungarian branch is run on a voluntary basis. We would like to host volunteers to add an international flavour to the everyday life of the branch, as well as to get to know new points of view and ideas concerning voluntarism and the work we are doing. Útilapu Hálózát intends to make the idea of voluntarism and workcamps more spread and popular in Hungary, especially among the youth. The volunteers will help our organisation to involve more people in the activities in this area.
Gewenste/vereiste vaardigheden & houding The volunteers should be open-minded, creative, initiative. In order to communicate they should preferably speak some English and ready to learn Hungarian, which is indispensable for working with socially underprivileged youth or people from underdeveloped regions. The vols should be ready to travel in Hungary. They should bring their own ideas, personalities and cultures into the life of our organisation.
Accommodatie en voorzieningen Acc: The volunteers will share an apartment in Budapest rented by Útilapu. Linguistic support: The volunteers will participate in an intensive language course in the first few weeks. After that language classes will be provided twice a week. Personal support: Besides the trainings organised by the National Agency, the volunteers will be given the opportunity to participate in trainings and seminars organised by Útilapu or its international organisation, Service Civil International. The Útilapu staff will provide the necessary training for the tasks to be performed by the volunteer and give support in the adaptation period and afterwards.
Periode We need vols for the period of 8 months, from March - November 2005 In principle the volunteers will work five days per week, 6-8 hours per day. Usually weekends are free, but in the summer season this may vary. Volunteers will have days off according to personal agreement.

Overig: Hosting vols would also be a great opportunity for the members and the target group of our organisation to be part of an intercultural experience. Furthermore we would like to meet the challenge of introducing the vols to our organisation, country and culture thereby helping them in their personal development through intercultural learning.
